

THE PEDAGOGICAL APPROACH OF R.A.D.I.Ka.l.A'S PROJECTS

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Goals:

1. Laying the foundation for a lifelong understanding of the ecological cycle and to create conditions for the children to see the context and, in a concrete way, see how their own environmental impact may be beneficial
2. Giving the children a positive sense of the future and a feeling that they are actually shaping our world
3. Creating community around a good cause as well as collectively using physical activity to promote health and environmental protection
4. Being able to experience real-time and at the individual level how physical activity contributes to the final goal
5. Involving different parts of the society in a rewarding way
6. Giving the children a sense of participation and responsibility for the shared environment
7. Including teachers, parents, companies and organizations that serve as role models for our **children**

How:

1. By concretizing a kind of cycle and laying the level of a child-graspable way,
 2. (they can later understand and apply the same principle in a broader context)
 3. To physically experience results by participating in different parts of the process, (relationship between action and consequence - work (bicycle / streak) leads to result (sailing lessons)).
 4. Starting point in the theoretical perspective phenomenology where the feeling / expression precedes the verbal,
 5. (You need to know something to be able to tell it and seek to create an understanding of it)
 6. Collective learning allows children and adults to share experiences and ideas
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
